

**HANDICAPPED/DISABLED VETERANS
PARKING BY-LAW**

**Adopted Article 17 Annual Town Meeting May 17, 1982;
Amended Article 16, Annual Town Meeting, May 20, 1991;
Amended Article 9 Special Town Meeting March 29, 2004**

No person, except those authorized by Chapter 40, Section 21, Clause 23 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth shall leave a vehicle unattended within off street parking spaces designated as reserved for vehicles owned and operated by disabled veterans or handicapped persons nor shall such authorized vehicles be left in such a manner as to obstruct a curb ramp designed for use by handicapped persons as a means of egress to a street or public way. The penalty for violation hereof shall be one hundred (\$100.00) dollars for the first offense, two hundred (\$200.00) dollars for the second offense, and three hundred (\$300.00) dollars for each subsequent offense; for any such offense, the vehicle may be removed according to the provisions of section 120D of Chapter 266.
