

Discharge of Firearms By-Law
Annual Town Meeting
March 11, 1975
Article 36

To insure the public safety, to discharge of firearms is prohibited within the Town, provided, however that this By-law shall not apply to the lawful defense of life or property nor to any law enforcement officer acting within the scope of his official duties. A firearm under this By-law is defined as a pistol, revolver or other weapon of any description from which a shot or bullet can be discharged. Violation hereof shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$50.00 for each offense.
