

# **Somerset Recreation 2020 All Day Summer Program**

## **Policies and Procedures**

- Your child will be in a group of no more than 8 participants with 1-2 counselors
- There will be no off-site field trips.
- Shared equipment will be cleaned by the main tent supervisor after each use.
- A designated area will be created for children who are not feeling well.
- Each group will receive a bin with supplies for their “home base” for the year
- “Play zone board” will be displayed. Supervisors will choose activities/locations for the 4 different times during the day.
- Children are not required to wear masks. However, social distancing will be adhered to.
- Employees are required to wear face coverings UNLESS an employee can easily, continuously, and measurably maintain at least 6 ft. of distance from other employees for the duration of his/her work
- Parents are asked to stay on the parking lot side of the park and in their cars at all time.
- Each supervisor will go through a daily wellness screening prior to the start of the program
- Each child will go through a daily wellness screening with their assigned counselor, during morning routine in their “home base”.
- Each group will be given hand sanitizer to be used throughout the day (especially during attendance, restroom use, snack, lunch, end of activities and dismissal) – children are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer if preferred
- Children are not required to social distance within their “Group.”
- Groups will maintain at least 14 ft between “groups.”

## **Children Drop off/Pick-up Procedures**

- Parents are asked to stay in the car AT ALL TIMES
- Staggered dismissal times will be designated – starting at 3:00 pm
- 1 gate will be used to enter/exit
  - On arrival campers will go to their “Home Base”
- At drop off parents must attest that they have read through the wellness screening and that their child was cleared to enter. (Children will be screened in their “Home Base” as well)
- Late arrivals (after 9:30 am) & early dismissals (before 2:30) will still go through the main tent. are encouraged to bring labeled water bottles and label all other belongings.

## **Exclusion for Health Reasons**

- If your child or anyone in your household is sick (see symptoms below) your child will not be allowed to come to the program and will not be able to return for 72 hours (3 days) without any symptoms.
- Symptoms that will result in exclusion include but may not be limited to; fever of 100.4 or higher, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, runny nose, chills, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, muscle pain, diarrhea, vomiting, abdominal pain and rash or change in skin color.
- If anyone in your household has coronavirus, we are required to report it to the Department of Health and your child will not be allowed to return to the program until cleared by the DOH.
- If a child begins to show symptoms of illness (see above list of symptoms) during the program day, s/he will be isolated away from other children with one adult until they are picked up.
- Any child who has been in direct contact with or has been exposed to anyone who has been confirmed to have coronavirus will be excluded from the program, pending guidance from the Board of Health

## **Daily Schedule Detailed**

1. GROUPS – Each child will be placed in a group with no more 10 children (This group will remain consistent throughout the week)
2. GROUP LOCATIONS – each group will have a “Home Base” & be at least 12 ft apart – shaded area with picnic table and/or mats, baskets will be provided for belongings
3. DROP OFF – 1 assigned entrance gates – participants go to their designated location – parents/guardians do not leave their cars or come into the park
4. MORNING ROUTINE – wellness screening, lunch order, attendance, pledge, announcements in their “Home Base”
5. ACTIVITIES – At least 8 “Play Zones” 12 ft apart, equipment specific to each group – each group will go to predetermined location
6. SNACKS/LUNCH– Groups will have snacks and lunch at their home base
7. DISMISSAL – Groups will be dismissed from their “Home Base” using the 3 assigned areas. A staggered dismissal time will take place starting with younger groups at 3:00 pm.
