## Spirit of Somerset Soap Box Race – Rules

1. All cars and drivers will be weighed upon check-in and assigned a number. The information will be placed on a label attached to the vehicle. Cars with more than one driver will have more than one label.
2. Stock cars are defined as those cars utilizing unaltered wheels that come with the kit.
3. Modified cars are defined as those cars using any altered wheels or wheels that do not come with the kit.
4. Stock cars will race against stock cars; modified cards against modified cars. The top three finishers in each division will receive corresponding trophy.
5. Any racer who does not win either of their first two races will not advance (double elimination).
6. All racers who win both or one of their races advances into the next round.
7. From this round forward any car that loses a race is eliminated (sudden death).
8. Each racer will then race another randomly selected opponent within their division, but not necessarily within their age group. This is where the combined weight of the racer and the car come into play. Race officials may attempt to “even out” the lighter racer/car with the use of weighted sand bags.
9. Racing will continue in this matter until it comes down to the final four racers. At this point they will race each other to determine final standing.
